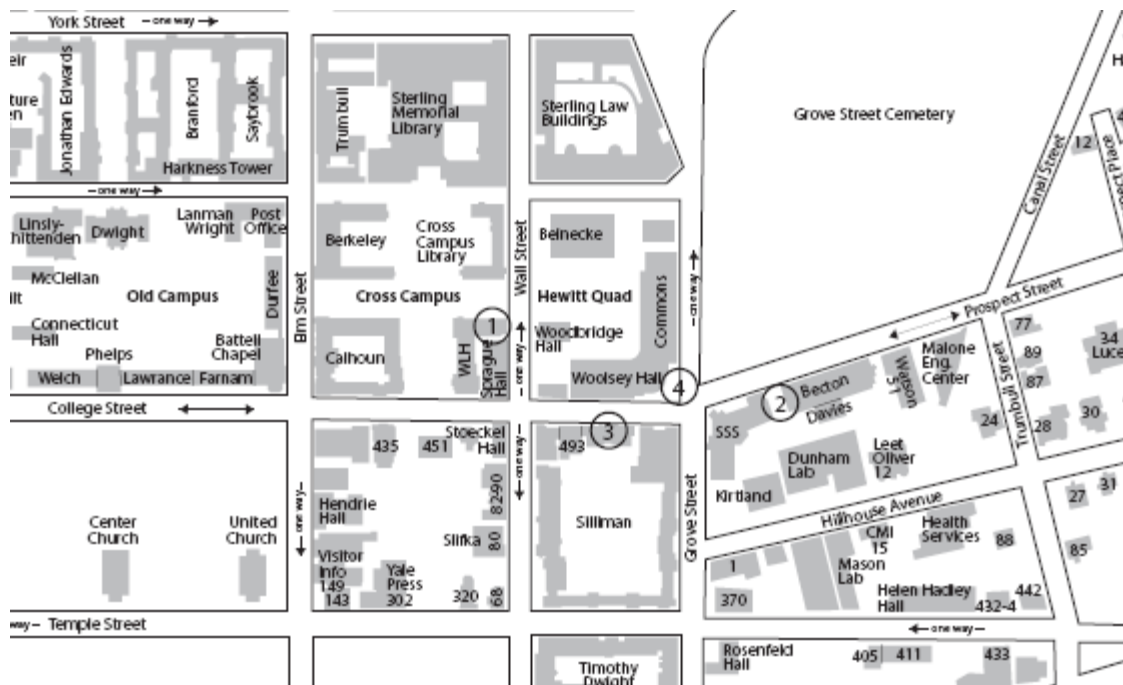

Registration will take place at **Silliman College** which takes up an entire city block of the Yale Campus in New Haven, CT. The map below shows Silliman College between the parallel streets of College and Temple Streets. Students should arrive at the Yale Campus between 11:00 and 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, June 28.

Registration will take place under the archway on at 344 Temple St. The Silliman Archway is located directly across the street from Timothy Dwight College. You can view a photo of this archway by using the “Street View” tool in Google Maps. Type “344 Temple St., New Haven, CT” as the address when using Google to search for directions.

Directions for Students Driving by Car Silliman College - 344 Temple St. , New Haven, CT

Interstate 95

From the north: Connect to I-91 North in New Haven; take Exit 3 (Trumbull Street) and follow directions below for I-91.

From the south: Connect to I-91 North in New Haven (left exit); take Exit 3 (Trumbull Street) and follow directions below for I-91.

Interstate 91

From the north or south: Take Exit 3 (Trumbull Street). Turn left onto Temple Street and continue for 1 ½ blocks. Look for Silliman College on your right and Junior State signs after you cross Grove St.

Parking

Parking meters are free on Sundays on the streets around Silliman. The closest parking will be on any street that borders Silliman which would include Temple St., Wall St., College St., and Grove St. Commercial parking facilities are located throughout the city.

Students Coming by Train

At the New Haven railroad station, take a taxi to the Visitor Center. The taxi stand is located in front of Union Station.

Students Coming by Plane to Bradley Airport

All students must fly into Bradley Field, Hartford, Connecticut (BDL). Shuttles will be provided to the Yale campus. Arrival at all other airports would require the student to transfer to Yale on their own (directions below). Junior Statesmen staff will be at the Baggage Claim at Bradley to assist students arriving on June 28 from 11:00 to 5:00 p.m.

Airport shuttles from Bradley to Yale will begin at 11 a.m. The last pick-up will be at 5:00 p.m. There are two air terminals with baggage claim areas and they are close to one another. Arriving students should look for JSA staff holding JSA signs at the bottom of the escalator in the **Terminal A Baggage Claim area**.

Once you arrive at Bradley, first claim your luggage then find the Junior Statesmen staff or rallying point. If you can't find them, call the Junior Statesmen Yale Office at **203-432-2344**. If you arrive at times outside of our provided shuttle service, use the red courtesy telephone to request Connecticut Limousine Service (CLS) to New Haven. Information may be obtained in advance by calling CLS at 800/472-5466 (www.ctlimo.com). Service from the airport to New Haven is frequent (about once every hour), takes about 1 ½ hours and costs approximately \$34 each way. Students should take a cab from the New Haven CLS Terminal to Silliman College on the Yale campus (\$10-\$12).

Students Arriving from Airports Other than Bradley

Tweed Airport, New Haven: First, claim your luggage then take a cab to Silliman College (\$14-\$20). Please note that this airport is only for **U.S. Airways Express**. Other airlines do not fly into Tweed.

From Kennedy, LaGuardia or Newark Airports: First claim your luggage. Then go to the Port Authority Ground Transportation Center, located in the Baggage Claim Area of each terminal, and request Connecticut Limousine Service (CLS) to New Haven. Information may be obtained in advance by calling CLS at 800/472-5466 (www.ctlimo.com).

At Kennedy Airport there is no Port Authority Ground Transportation Center. Instead, just use the CLS Direct Line Courtesy Phone located in the Baggage Claim Area. Conn. Limousine service from these airports to New Haven is frequent (about once every hour), takes about 3 hours and costs approximately \$51 (\$98 round-trip).

Those arriving outside the suggested time/date guidelines should take a cab from the New Haven CLS Terminal to Silliman College, 344 Temple St. on the Yale campus (\$10-\$12).
