Virtual Learning

GoogleClassrooms will be the platform for our virtual Institute. Students will be added to the GoogleClassroom one week before the Institute begins. All class materials and communication will be shared here.

It is expected that students participate actively on GoogleClassroom completing assignments and contributing to discussions in a timely manner.

Age Group

For our Institutes, the material is primarily aimed for 10th - 12th graders. The youngest group who can sign up for the Institutes are 9th graders.

Time Commitment

There will be a combination of set class time meetings and individual work to be completed independently between meetings. There is an orientation meeting on July 29, and the first session is Saturday, July 31. In total, there will be 7 scheduled sessions of approximately 2-3 hours each, all at 1pm PT. Participation and Assignments

Even though we are meeting virtually, active participation from all members is necessary and expected. Although assignments will not be graded, students are expected to participate in most synchronous sessions, and complete a majority of the coursework to receive their certificate of completion. Students who do not, will not be able to participate in organized completion activities. If there is one week of non-participation in the class (i.e. not attending set class time or completing assignments) students will be dropped from the Institute without a refund.

Refund Policy

JSA does not offer refunds. If for some reason a student is unable to attend a program they have paid for, they will receive credit to attend a future program. No credit will be offered once the program has begun.
